

Gift Aid Declaration

If you wish to support WYFC by making a financial gift and you pay UK Income Tax we are able to obtain a tax refund from the Inland Revenue. This refund would increase the value of your gift by 25%. For example, a gift of £100 would grow to £125 after claiming Gift Aid. This extra £25 is then released into the ministry of WYFC at no extra cost to you. Gift Aid is reclaimed by the charity from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.
